A+ CERTIFICATION:

The CompTIA A+ certification is the industry standard for computer support technicians and a starting point for a career in IT. This certification proves competency in areas including installation, preventative maintenance, networking, security, and troubleshooting. The exam covers maintenance of PCs, mobile devices, laptops, operating systems, and printers.

NETWORK+ CERTIFICATION:

CompTIA's Network+ is a mid-level certification for IT professionals and proves a technical competency in managing, maintaining, troubleshooting, installing, and configuring basic computer networks. The exam contains situational, traditional, and identification questions.

MCSA: WINDOWS 10 CERTIFICATION:

The Microsoft Certified Solutions Associate: Windows 10 certification validates your skills to configure, manage, and maintain a Windows 10 enterprise system and qualifies you for a position as a computer support specialist. Two exams are required to achieve MCSA certification: either Implementing and Managing Windows 10 -or- Deploying and Managing Windows 10 in the Enterprise, and Installing and Configuring Windows 10.
